Saturday, March 23, Noon – Dinnertime



expected stops for refreshments and lunch, and route map will be distributed.

## In the Mirror: 2019 Enthusiasts Dinner

The Desert Stars' wrap up of auction week in Scottsdale, Arizona, our annual Mercedes-Benz Enthusiast Dinner, was held on Saturday, January 19, 2019 at Venue 8600. Attendees from each of the Arizona Sections, as well as two other sections, from California, and as far as Missouri, came together to celebrate the brand.

Local members held the annual "People's Choice" car show in the parking lot, which featured Mercedes-Benz cars from the 50's, 60's to present. This year's dozen or so entries ran the gamut from roadsters, coupes, SUVs and Geländewagen. There were also some of the latest Mercedes-Benz models on display by local dealer, Schumacher European Mercedes-Benz, for all to enjoy and take in.

The People's Choice award winners were as follows: in third place, a tie, between Richard Schulte's 1966 230S and Robert Yoder's 2018 AMG GT Roadster. Second place went to Richard Sharp's 1953 300 S Coupe, a perennial favorite. The top spot, by a wide margin, was the 1963 300 SL Roadster of Dr. Philip Lutfy, which has originally purchased by his father, in Phoenix, Arizona. Congratulations to the winners and to all the participants whose love of their vehicles is clearly evident.

Following cocktails and dinner Mr. Andy Reid provided the attendees with his insight and knowledge on Mercedes-Benz cars that were offered for sale at the week's events. The auction market was unusually harsh to some top brands, like Ferrari and Mercedes, but rewarding to others, such as limited-edition Porsches. Perhaps due to the economic uncertainty of our times, most vehicles struggled to meet the auction house's value expectations. However, 300SL Gullwings and roadsters still remain million-dollar cars. Good example 190SLs remain in the low \$120,000 range. With three SLR McLaren's offered this week, they could be the best value for a modern "supercar" out there.






